- Assembly bill 1861 Pam Lampitt, John McKeon and Nancy Pinkin.. Referred to Assembly Health and Senior Services Committee.
- 3. Assembly 2186 To prohibit restraint of female inmates during labor and childbirth (huttle et al.).
- Senate Bill 495- Establishes maternal mortality review commission (Vitale, Ruiz) and Assembly Bill 1862 (Lampitt, Mukherji, Huttle and Pinkin)
- 5. Assembly Bill 314 restricts use of solitary confinement in state prisons, jails, detention facilities (pinkin et al)
- 6. **Senate 108** Establishes a program in to facilitate the community reintegration of certain domestic violence victims following their incarceration for crimes against their abusers. (Weinberg)
